Eccl 11:7-12:14

1. Read Eccl. 11:7-10.
 - What simple pleasure of life is found in v. 7? Are you thankful for every new day?

 - How are we to spend the years of our lives? (v. 8) What are the *days of darkness*? Why does Solomon tell us to remember them?

 - List several points of advice he gives to young men. (vv. 9-10)

2. Read Eccl. 12:1-5. What does it mean to *Remember your Creator*? Why does he command us to do so in the days of your youth?

3. List the wonderfully descriptive terms he used and try to relate them to different aspects of old age. (12:2-5)

4. Read Eccl. 12:6-8. Compare 12:6-7 to 12:1. How are they similar? (The chain and bowl are probably describing a hanging lamp that fell and was broken) What is meaningless?

5. Read Eccl. 12:9-12. What was the purpose and intent of the proverbs?

6. Read Eccl. 12:13-14. What was the author's conclusion of the matter?

7. What did you gain from this study? Is everything meaningless?
