- 5. How would you define sexual immorality?
- 6. Re-read 1 Th 4:3-8 along with 1 Cor. 6:18-20. Our culture often defends immorality on the grounds of love. Why is sexual immorality wrong?
- 7. Re-read 1 Th 4:9-10. What positive encouragement and admonition about loving one another are found here? (See also John 13:34-35, 15:9-10, 12, 17)

8. Re-read 1 Th 4:11-12. What three-fold instruction does Paul give them? Why?
