- 3. What opposition did they encounter in Paphos? Why did Paul sharply condemn this sorcerer? What good came from this conflict? What does the teach you about the work of the Holy Spirit?
- 4. Why do you think John Mark left them in Perga? (See also Acts 15:36-39)
