- 4. Read Acts 14:8-13. Lystra was a Roman colony with a mixture of pagan beliefs and without a synagogue. Paul's ministry began by healing a crippled man. What are we told about his condition, his faith, and the reaction of the crowd?
- 5. Read Acts 14:14-18. How did Paul describe the religion of the Lycaonians?
- 6. Compare Paul's message to the people in Lystra to his previous message in Pisidian Antioch. How and why were they different?
- 7. Read Acts 14:19-20. What can be learned about effective ministry from Paul in Lystra?
- 8. Paul was stoned in Lystra. It was severe enough that they thought he was dead. Why did the Jews hate him so?
- 9. Read Acts 14:21-28. How was the missionaries' experience in Derbe different from the other places they had visited? How does this show God's grace and care for his servants?
- 10. Why did Paul and Barnabas retrace their steps before returning home?
