5.	You may have some of the same questions and concerns experienced by the Thessalonians. How were you encouraged by what Paul wrote?
6.	Read 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11. What was their next big question that Paul addressed in this passage?
7.	What main point about the coming "day of the Lord" did Paul make in each of the following?  • 5:1-3
