3.	List several reasons why Paul was so intent on going to Jerusalem that he would not be dissuaded? (see also Acts 20:22)
4.	Paul's followers continued to warn him and plead with him not to go. Do you think Paul was right or wrong in going to Jerusalem this last time? Why? (There are different opinions among Christians about this.)
5.	Read Acts 21:17-26. How was Paul initially received by the brothers in Jerusalem? What was the continuing problem within the church?
6.	What did they ask Paul to do? Do you think Paul was right or wrong in doing what they asked? Why or why not?
7.	Read Acts 21:27-36. What led up to Paul's arrest? List the parallels between the treatment of Paul and of Christ. Should we expect mankind to treat Christians better than they did Christ?
8.	Why do you think God allowed all this to happen to Paul, his humble servant, that He loved so much?
