- 3. Read 1 Cor. 15:12-22. According to Paul in 1 Cor. 15:14, *If Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith.* Why?
- 4. Re-read Acts 26:16-18. In recounting the commission given to him by the risen Christ, how does he describe:
 - The lost condition of mankind?
 - The content of salvation?
 - The means of salvation?
- 5. Read Acts 26:19-23. What do you learn about obedience from Paul's example?
- 6. How should one's life evidence the reality of saving faith? (v. 20)
- 7. Read Acts 26:24-27. Why do you think Festus interrupted him? Do you think he really thought Paul was insane? Why or why not?
- 8. Read Acts 26:28-32. How was Paul actually the judge, and Agripa and Festus the ones on trial? How did Paul put King Agrippa on the spot? How did Agrippa respond?
- 9. What was Paul's ultimate motive? (vs. 29, 1 Cor. 9:16-23, 2 Cor. 5:14-15) How was that reflected in his attitude toward Festus and Agrippa? Is it also true in your life?
