Lesson 28 Acts 27:1-44

1.	Read Acts 27:1-5. Who was making the journey to Rome with Paul? What blessing did Paul receive from Julius in the early part of the voyage?
2.	Read Acts 27:6-13. What decision did the Centurion make in Myra? Why did Paul warn them not to go further than Fair Havens?
3.	What factors influenced Julius' decision to sail on to Phoenix? How do we sometimes get ourselves into problems for the same reasons?
4.	Read Acts 27:14-20. What did the sailors do to try to save the vessel and their lives? Did their efforts bring them any "calm in the storm"?
5.	Read Acts 27:21-26. The seasoned sailors were terrified and panicked, yet Paul remained calm and fearless. What gentle rebuke did he give them? How did he encourage them? (v. 22) What was the basis of the encouragement he offered them?
6.	How would Paul's relationship to God (v. 23) enable him to stay calm in the crisis?
7.	Read Acts 27:27-32. What mistake did Paul prevent?
8.	Read Acts 27:33-38. What practical advice did he give them?
9.	Read Acts 27:39-44. Why did the soldiers want to kill the prisoners? Why do you think the Centurion wanted to spare Paul's life?

10. What lessons about living in the midst of the "storms of life" did you learn from this account?
