- 1. Read Galatians 1:18-2:5, keeping in mind that Paul is telling his personal testimony to the Galatians. What can we learn of Titus from this passage? What committment to the Gospel does Titus demonstrate in verses 3-5?
- 2. The next time we hear of Titus, it is in reference to his role in the Corinthian church. Read 2 Corinthians 7:5-16. What job was Titus given by Paul in the Corinthian church? What was his relationship with Paul?
- 3. Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-7 and 16-24. What can we learn of Titus' heart, calling, and character from all that Paul says?
- 4. Read Paul's concluding remarks in 2 Corinthians 12:14-18. Based on what you already know of Paul's ministry and calling, along with this passage, what character qualities must Titus share with Paul in his gospel ministry?
- 5. Titus was entrusted by Paul with the task of building up the church on the island of Crete. Read the following passages. (If you have time, consider reading the entire book of Titus.) Record the specific commands Paul gives to Titus in each passage, (please keep in mind that there are more than I have listed here). What can we learn regarding his character and, more importantly, the transforming work of the gospel and the characteristics that constitute a healthy church body?
