1 Thessalonians is a letter written by Paul to the church he had founded in Thessalonica on his second missionary journey. In order to have the right context, we will start with that account found in the beginning of Acts 17.

4.	Read 1 Thessalonians 1:1-3. What can be learned about this church from Paul's greeting to them in vs. 1?	
5.	To whom does Paul express thanks for their existence? (v. 2) Why? (vv. 4-5)	
6.	What three foundational facts of Christian character does Paul commend in the Thessalonians in v. 3?	
7.	What do you think each of those mean practically, and how are they demonstrated in real life?
