4.	Read Acts 2:14-41. What change has occurred in Peter? (See also Luke 2:33-34, 54-62.) How is that an encouragement to you personally?
5.	Peter began his sermon by applying OT prophecy. On whom would God pour out His Spirit? (vv. 17-18) What was God's ultimate purpose and promise? (v. 21)
6.	Who was Peter's audience? What did he tell them about Jesus? What was the result? (vv. 22-37)
7.	What was the solution to their problem (and every person's problem)? How effective was his sermon? What does this teach you about effective evangelism? (vv. 38-41)
8.	Read Acts 2:42-47. What characterized this first "church"?
9.	Go back over this chapter and make a list of the "acts of the Holy Spirit". Considering the fact that the same Holy Spirit indwells all believers, how might some of these apply to you?
