- 2. How did God respond to the arrest of his Apostles? (5:19-21a) What did the high priest and his associates do the next morning? (5:21b-26)
- 3. What charges did the high priest bring against them before the Sanhedrin? (5:27-28)
- 4. What were the five major points of Peter's response? (5:29-32)
- 5. Why do you think the leaders so furious that they wanted to put the Apostles to death?
- 6. Who was Gamaliel? What was his advice to them? (5:33-39)
- 7. Where did Gamaliel's advice fall short? Is it possible to remain neutral about Jesus Christ?
- 8. What was the leaders final decision? (5:40-42)
- 9. How did the apostles respond to their punishment? Was it effective? (Matt 5:10-12, Phil 1:29-30, 1 Peter 4:14)
- 10. How is their pattern of evangelism applicable to us? (5:42)
