1 Peter

1. Read 1 Peter 1:1-12. How does Peter describe the gift of salvation in these verses? (Where does it come from? How are we saved? What are the effects of salvation?)
2. Read 1 Peter 1:13-2:3. What commands does Peter give to his recipients? What motive does he give for this behavior?
3. Read 1 Peter 2:4-10. What analogy does Peter use for the Christian life and the body of Christ? What purpose do believers have?
4. Read 1 Peter 2:11-3:7. This section contains several commands about living godly lives among unbelievers. What commands stand out to you? What is the desired outcome for godly behavior that Peter lists in this section? (There are several.)
5. Read 1 Peter 3:8-4:2. Peter repeatedly speaks about suffering as a reality for the believer. What purpose does it have in the lives of those who follow Christ? For further insight, review 1:6-9 and 2:19-23 or see 4:12-19.
6. Read 1 Peter 4:1-11. What characteristics of a Christ-like life stand out to you in this passage? What is the purpose of living Christ-like?
7. Read 1 Peter 4:12-19. What kind of suffering could his recipients have been experiencing? How does Peter tell them to respond to or think about suffering?
8. Read 1 Peter 5:1-14. This last chapter in Peter's letter is extremely autobiographical. What admonitions does he give his recipients? Who is he addressing specifically? What is his ultimate goal?
